



ADDITIONAL FEES 2026-27

We offer a range of optional opportunities beyond the classroom, enabling students to build exceptional portfolios, explore interests, and shape future pathways.

Biology Field Trip	£650	The compulsory Year 12 Biology field trip supports required practical endorsement work and ecology-based practicals assessed in Year 13.
EPQ	£1545	The Extended Project Qualification is equivalent to half an A Level and allows students to independently explore an academically useful topic linked to their current studies or future aspirations.
Duke of Edinburgh Award	£875	The Duke of Edinburgh's Award offers Bronze, Silver and Gold levels, requiring commitment to activities alongside a challenging expedition that develops teamwork, resilience and practical skills.
LAMDA	£825	This externally run course leads to a recognised LAMDA qualification that supports university applications while developing transferable skills that enhance academic study and future career pathways.
Languages	£1995	An annual fee applies for students who choose to take native languages at A Level or GCSE, or require extra English As An Additional Language (EAL) lessons. Although these may be a student's native language, attendance is compulsory to ensure appropriate preparation and strong exam performance. Students receive two hours of weekly group tuition from specialist tutors at OIC, with the qualification potentially strengthening university applications.
Perlego	£120	Perlego gives students unlimited digital access to over 500,000 academic titles, supporting wider reading, independent exploration
HeadStart	£3499	Pre-sessional course for Year 12 students.
Pre Sessional UCAS Programme	£2475	A tailor made one week programme providing early support to students in preparation for their university applications. The programme takes place prior to the start of term and focuses on crucial UCAS university advice and training for their applications and interviews.
